



CONVICTED CASES

On Wednesday, February 12, 2025, Cody Holum, 18, of Doniphan, NE, was sentenced to 80 to 160 years in prison for five felonies in Grand Island, NE. Holum pleaded no contest to two counts of first-degree sexual assault of a minor, two counts of first-degree sexual assault, and one count of human trafficking. He was sentenced to 20 to 40 years for each charge, with the sexual assault sentences consecutively and the human trafficking sentence concurrently. The crimes, which occurred between April 2019 and October 2023, involved blackmailing 13 individuals with explicit photos.



YOU KNOW...

Today's children have near-constant access phones and devices, making online socializing a normal part of growing up. Unfortunately, this digital world has led to issues like sextortion and Child Sexual Abuse Material (CSAM). Sextortion involves perpetrators coercing individuals, often minors, to produce explicit content through threats of exposure. This can result in the creation of CSAM, as explicit images of child abuse are created and shared. Both crimes exploit digital platforms, highlighting the urgent need for better protections and stricter regulations on these platforms.
